Dear Partners and Friends,

Greetings in the name of Jesus. We pray all is well with you as you take the time to read our letter. The summer is here and has been here for over a month. If the May and June temperatures are any indication of what is to come, July and August will see temperatures of over 130 degrees. As the weather is heating up, so is Spain. Huge fires are blazing in the southwest of Spain, like never seen before.

The first weekend in June we were able to go down to Salobreña for a long weekend to celebrate our anniversary. Also in June, we were delighted to spend time with the daughter and granddaughter of some long-time friends and supporters that live in Kansas. Our visitors were on a mother-daughter tour before the granddaughter's wedding. We met them both many years ago on our visit to Kansas when the granddaughter was a baby.

Ann is feeling much better after all of her physical therapy. There is still some pain but with taking care not to lift heavy things, she is almost back to normal. Thank you so much for your prayers. Our usual ministries also continue as normal. Unlike last summer, the attendance at our weekly Bible study at the hotel has decreased. We are working our way through the book of Hebrews. What a great High Priest we have in Jesus!

We have submitted our applications for our residency visa renewals. If approved, these will renew for five years. Please pray that they will be approved soon and we can complete the process before our trip to the States in September.

The fraternity of Pastors in the Córdoba province meets monthly to share burdens and plan projects and conferences. We recently purchased 2,000 Bibles to be used for distribution in hospitals, prisons, etc. So few people here ever read the Bible and we pray that because of these Bibles that will be given free, more people will do so.

Now to the above Scripture. Madrid, the Spanish capitol, is serving as the 2017 host of World Pride, the international event promoting the LGTBI collective or what the Bible calls perversion and sexual immorality. They are expecting 2.5 million visitors between June 23 and July 2. The crosswalk signals in Madrid (see on back page) have been changed to show



homosexuals and lesbians. Others of them have complained because their particular brand of perversion was not displayed in the signals. The perversion in their parades shown on television make Mardi Gras in New Orleans look like Sunday School.

We are writing this on June 26. This coming Wednesday, June 28, the second and third largest political parties in Spain, both Socialists, will introduce a new law in the Spanish Parliament. Among a host of other things, the new law would:

- Create a new State Agency, independent of the Public Administration, to enforce the provisions of the law.
- Reward tax rebates and subsidies to employees hiring these people.
- Require every public registry to reflect the “felt identity” of these people.
- Allow them to compete in their “felt identity” category of sports.
- Outlaw the publishing on the internet, by email or social media any expression, images or content that are offensive or vexatious. The first violation of this provision brings a fine of up to 3,000 euros. A repeat offense raises the fine up to 20,000 euros.



The internet protocol of offenders can be blocked.

- Impose a fine of up to 45,000 euros or the closure of a facility for promoting or performing “therapies for reversing sexual orientation or gender identity.” These penalties can be imposed regardless of whether the person receiving the therapy has requested it. The proposed law states that “the consent given by the person submitted to them [the therapy] is irrelevant for the application of the penalty.
- Reverse the burden of proof, that is, that entity or person who is accused of discrimination must be the one who provides objective and reasonable justification, sufficiently proven, not to have committed the discrimination.

The provinces of Madrid, Barcelona and several other large cities already have this law in place. No doubt it will become the law of the land here. This law reveals the deception Satan has over them. They want a law that guarantees their protection, but that very law guarantees their condemnation. (1 Corinthians 6:9-10; Revelation 21:8; 22:15.)

Spain wants to lead the world in sexual perversion and this law will help. When passed, it will be against the law to help people to not be like them. The provisions of this law are only one small step short of requiring all people to be like them.

We have anchored ourselves to the Word of God and will go where it leads us. If you are anchored to the culture of the world you will go where it is going – condemnation (1 Corinthians 11:32). It may become against the law here for us to offer the way out of their condemnation. There is hope for them. Titus 3:3-5 describes where we were: “For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures”, and then, “But when the kindness and the love of God our savior toward man appeared...He saved us.”

Needless to say, when this law is passed, this letter sent to Globe by email from Spain will be against the law. We are prepared to offer them that way of escape from their condemnation if it costs us all of our money, our freedom or our lives. We can do no less for them than Jesus did for us.

Thank you so much for your prayers and support. Please pray for us as we pray for you.
