Dear Partners and Friends,

The above Scripture is one that the Lord has given us to encourage us in our journey as His missionaries. It has often brought us comfort and strength in difficult and dangerous situations. Perhaps you need encouragement today in your walk with the Lord. Those who have followed our ministry for almost 25 years know that we have been through some difficult times and are still going. God knows your situation and is well able to bring you through and even to give you rest in the midst of your trials. We have proved Him and found Him faithful. What a wonderful Lord we serve.

Our Spain visas have just been approved for another five years. Thank you so much for helping us pray for this. The work here is very difficult spiritually, and we have felt that the Lord wanted us to pause and evaluate and pray over our work here in Spain. After almost five years of teaching the Bible Study, Jack has felt led to end it at least until the beginning of next year and seek the Lord to see if there is anything that He wants us to do differently. The Red Box ministry in the plaza and the prayer meeting in our home continue. We continue to minister to the homeless on the streets and to do whatever we feel the Lord calls us to do here. Please help us pray for the Lord's will to be done and that we will be strong to carry out His plan in Spain.

This summer we were able to sponsor a young person to attend summer camp. We have a heart for the young people here and almost every year it has been our privilege to be able to sponsor one. Also, we have been able to help some of the homeless with medical and other needs that they would have no way of getting help for otherwise. It is because of your support for us that we are able to help in situations of need as they arise.

Our hearts were heavy as we followed the tragedy of the mudslides in Freetown, Sierra Leone. The village of Regent that was buried by the mountain that collapsed is very familiar to us. We used to travel a dirt road over the mountain to get to Freetown during the dry season. It took about two hours off the trip into Freetown and went through Regent. We had friends that lived there and we do not know their present condition. Please pray for Sierra Leone.

On September 7, we will be leaving Córdoba and taking a train to Malaga, Spain to catch a flight to London to catch a flight to Tampa the next day. We are looking so forward to being in the States and seeing our families and friends and some supporting churches again after over a year and a half of being here. As we only have a month, our time will be very limited. We would love to see and visit with each of you, but due to time limitations, that will not be possible this trip. And we will be visiting our friends in Scotland in November. Please pray that our journeys will go smoothly for these two older missionaries.

We appreciate each of you so very much, and thank you for all of your help, prayer and support that helps us to stay on the mission field of Spain. We pray that the Lord will bless you exceedingly abundantly above all that you could ask or think. We love you.
