The International Mission Board reports that there are still **6734 Unreached People Groups** in the world today, comprising over **3 billion people**. Globe is taking on this challenge! We are targeting some of these groups with a five-year plan to send missionaries and plant churches among them.

Over the past 20 years, mission-minded people, have been researching unreached people groups on every continent. What is an unreached people group? The most concise definition is: A group of people with a common language, ethnicity and culture who have little or no Christian witness or viable church presence among them. Some UPG's number in the millions. Others are only a few hundred. Some live in two or three geographical locations – often because of forced migration from war, natural disasters, or economic hardship. Most UPG's have less than 2% Christians in their midst. If the church exists among such people, it is so small and weak that it can never

tackle the evangelistic challenge of reaching all of their own people. Missionaries are needed: God's people who leave their home culture, go to another people, learn another language and culture, and live as a Christian witness among their host people. How long? Until they can effectively bring Christ and His Church to their adopted people group and start an indigenous Christian movement.
