This is a more personal letter, written at the beginning of a year that will certainly be a year that impacts our country greatly. Argentina will have provincial and national elections for President, and laws on abortion and gender laws are being passed. As Christians during 2018 we have marched, educated, spoken out and have tried to unite to face this onslaught, as it's also happening worldwide.

Inflation has hit an all time high of 50% annually, which has meant horrible inflation, prices have doubled and the economic situation here is complicated (more than usual!), poverty is on the rise, and unemployment is up.

As a family, we have many challenges ahead. Humberto and I are working with the Pastoral Council of Cordoba, gathering around 150 pastors in unity, and planning activities for our city, which are also impacting our nation. We have organized training for addictions, evangelistic events, and we have given out food to 18 churches with food programs and held leadership training. For 2019 we have a busy and urgent agenda with all that is happening.



Pray for us especially in these times, in which we are actively working with pastors and leaders of the nation, planning and being involved in promoting Christian values. We are reactivated our church website (www.iglemdv.com), our inspirational podcasts (www.pastillasparaelanimo.com.ar), producing videos, and I am publishing a book in Spanish with Christian Declarations this January. Plus, we had an art exposition with some of our oil paintings, our hobby!

Pray that our finances multiply, that we may be wise in the use of our time and resources, to continue to increment our efforts in Argentina, which needs a spiritual miracle at this time more than ever. Thank you for being there and praying for missionaries all over the world.
