A special event has been planned called Globe International Expo for April 29th this year plus a Missions Week. We have been invited to attend, so we are now buying our plane tickets. Each fare costs US\$ 800. A car rental will be around the same amount. We will be visiting in Pensacola, Orlando and Miami during those days before returning home to our work here.

### Why invest in the Jiménez-Saint family?

Because we have a heart for our country, Argentina. We are working today with monthly meetings with an average of 100 pastors at our church building, training them and organizing events to transform our city. We have been distributing food (the government donated two tons of food) to 36 churches that feed children and families. We are having our fourth pro-life march on March 25th, and we are supervising youth activities that involve our city. Our son Sebastian, in the middle of the photo below, is teaching a workshop at our church property. Our building has become a hub for our city, and from there we can reach out to our city. I finished my last book on Christian Declarations. With Humberto, we will be filming one minute videos on leadership, another project ahead.



Our son Ari is finishing filming the first episode (the pilot) of a Bible series for children here in Córdoba with local talent, which Globe has financed as an evangelistic project for Internet. It will be available very soon! Each episode costs around US\$ 1,000 but will be available for free to

the Spanish speaking world. In the photo is the project team, and Nathalie made the angel puppets. And yes, Humberto is acting also! (Ari is on the right, Nathalie and Sebastian bottom left). So much to write.... So much to do!

Pray that our finances may multiply so all these projects and more will be done and reach out to many!
