In addition to the time I spend every week with the upper level guys going through the material, I also do some type of recreational activity with all the residents on Thursdays. This allows me to begin building relationships with the new residents just coming into the program, so that when it's their turn to go through the restoration plan, we already have a good rapport together. This helps them open up and receive more.

Not only are the homeless blessed, but it's become a great training ground for witnessing. One resident said to me last week, "my confidence has grown so much since we've been doing these outreaches." Lives are being changed with the love of Jesus and our community is being reached through discipleship!
