These are serious times and sickness is out of our control, but not out of our Lord's control. So we must go to the One who loves and wants the best for those who love Him. We start every day with Psalm 91. What a wonderful way to start the day.

How has the world changed. Just a few weeks ago we were planning on our trip to the states for Globe mission conference in Pensacola and visiting several churches in Florida and Alabama. Now I have had to cancel those plans, airline tickets, and several speaking visits among the churches who support our mission at Alfa y Omega Christian school. I have decided to sit tight right here and see what God is saying to me.

So, that said, I'll fill you in a bit what we are facing here in Guatemala. I am well aware that you all who get my newsletter are living in very similar situations. We are in our second week of school shut down. All schools, public and private, are closed until this epidemic has come under control. We felt led on Friday to inform our students and parents the last day of classes, that we would be sending work to do at home via the internet if the schools were to close so they were prepared. Sure enough, on Monday, the government informed all schools in the whole country were closed until further notice. We were ready and have started our classes online so no one was left wondering what to do. Teachers, students, or parents. So that is the situation of our school. Now the Government has shut down borders, airports, all businesses that are not essential, and sent us all home to stay put in quarantine until this Corona 19 has run its course. Only citizens of Guatemala may come into the country. I am a resident so if I were to leave, I would not be allowed back in, or I would be put in a hospital in quarantine. So I decided it was best to just not do any traveling and wait out this time in all of our lives. This too will end. Let's continue to pray for each other. The pic enclosed is our last day of classes before the quarantine. We are praying and believing that we have a great God!
