Looking back on our time with Globe and even before that, we can see that God is not just good, He is life. For without Him nothing that we have accomplished this far could have been done. As we move forward, He continues to provide for us with finances and prayer warriors who continue to sacrifice to invest in God's work.

Since our last update, we were involved with a team of 60 from California who had an ambitious project, to hand out Bibles and or share the gospel with all of the residents of our community, Clarkston GA. We joined them in this effort. Even though we all fell short of that goal due to illness and other issues, 1,431 people received a bible. The majority of those heard the gospel. 1,462 people were not at home but received Bible literature left on their door. 318 people rejected Bibles. Interestingly 2 apartment complexes were covered that did not show up on Google Maps. Colleen and her team were able to share with a Karenni Burmese woman. They prayed for pain in her shoulder and back and she was healed. She was so moved that she cried. She indicated that she had lived 9 years in Clarkston and no one had visited and or prayed for her during that time. Armin's

team met with 2 boys. One of the boys had already given his life to the Lord. As we talked with both of them the other boy decided to follow Jesus. Both boys were excited and wanted us to meet their mothers. One of the mothers discussed how she was about at the end of her rope and was really struggling. The team prayed with her and she felt an emotional burden that was lifted. She felt much encouragement and discussed how we had shown up just in time to give her hope. Later a list was put together of all the contacts and follow up was planned with many who were already at work in the various apartment complexes in Clarkston.



Colleen and I joined a residency team that did some of the follow up in one of the apartment complexes. This residency team spends 2 hours in house church, 2 hours training, and 2 hours per week following up with contacts made with the team from California. We were able to connect with a Buddhist from Nepal who had asked for

follow up. He wanted a Bible and to learn more about Jesus. We provided a bible and a couple of follow up appointments have been made. His wife is also open. Interestingly their 3 children are going to a Christian church and know Jesus as their Savior.

Unexpectedly my dad from Ohio had some serious medical issues that needed our attention. We helped him during this process navigating the medical system and getting him on the road to recovery. As well during the process, he ended up back in the hospital and had to have his gall bladder removed. He ended up going to rehab twice and then went back home. We really noticed a difference due to the many prayer groups that were diligently praying for us and my dad. God was gracious and moved my dad to finally decide he needed to be closer to family and our children. This was a relief to us and an answer to our prayers to provide a safe comfortable environment that has a community to help him. Colleen and I developed flu-like symptoms that didn't make things any easier. Again God was good and gave us strength and endurance to weather the storm. We have since returned to GA to get back into the swing of things, going to the Clarkston Bible Institute, working with the soccer ministry, reengaging with the residency program, and doing training with "No Place Left." Again we want to thank all of you who helped us during this process to help my dad get on the road to recovery.
