Many of your youth have not received this foundation and one of our main goals is to strengthen their fundamental knowledge while completing their education which will greatly help them in the future. Our staff is working daily to complete construction projects, make homework copies for our youth, and planning for our new youth coming in 2021.

In conversation with my staff, they were overwhelmed with their kids being home all the time and nothing to do so I started finding educational homework pages, and Aunt Angie gave them all homework! They loved it! We made playdough for all the little kids and critical thinking exercises for all the big kids. June 1st is a holiday to celebrate children and BOHA blessed our staff kids by making cupcakes, drinks, and cookies, along with a small toy and they were all so blessed. One of my staff said her husband was so blessed he teared up! The kids played so much they fell asleep holding their new toy. Most families buy the kids a gift that is something they really need. It cost them too much for toys, so we were able to bless the kids and their families.



Hi, my name is Margarida, I am the teacher at BOHA, and have worked here for 5 years, I love my job! I can help teens learn and work with people.
