Hopefully, we can test my stamina and take a trip to North Carolina to see family and dear friends. We had the delight of seeing Ronnie come to Christ in the Bahamas nearly 20 years ago. Shirley met his wife, shared that we had a Bible study in our home, and asked them to come. Sue said she would like to, but her husband wouldn't be interested. In God's divine plan, both came and Ronnie soon got saved. We are heart-connected and long to see them again.

Pastor Misi baptized 5 college students from A Haz recently using the outdoor swimming pool at Dorcas Camping Grounds, a Christian retreat center that is a few miles outside of Debrecen, Hungary. Friends reported, some damage, mostly limbs, lots of power outages, and flooding but God's protection was apparent. Hallelujah!!! Some areas flooded here as well but we needed the 4" of rain. Friends and family in Oregon have seen and smelled smoke from those ravaging fires but they are safe.

We thank you for your love towards us expressed in your prayers of faith, your encouraging calls, emails, letters, and your selfless generosity in support that continues to help meet our needs.
