## Hello from Mozambique,

The boys who are in the 10th grade are back at BOHA because they will have to sit for exams in January. They are attending school twice a week and studying with our teacher, as they need to cram 8 months of school into 2 ½ months. Our other students will not be returning as school will not resume for all other grades. Currently, the government is planning to pass all students to the next grade. I know that sounds strange, but in Mozambique, we don't have the option for online school and the student-teacher ratio is 60:1. To comply with the COVID guidelines, there are now 20 students per classroom and this is causing space issues. Our youth are back to cutting grass, working in the garden, cooking, cleaning, and caring for our animals, along with their studies. Please continue to pray for our youth!

We are all excited for 2 of our youth who will be graduating from BOHA and will be starting 11th grade and trade school. We are very proud of them as they have grown into great young men.

As we look ahead to next year, 2 youth will be returning for their last year at BOHA and 10 new youth will enter the project. COVID has not stopped us or the youth's desire to enter the ministry. Once again word of mouth about Beacon of Hope has brought us 10 new youth. My staff and I had planned to visit our new youth before the end of the year, but as cost continue to rise, we may not be able to do so.

Your faithful prayers and monthly support make it possible for BOHA and my family to help so many people. Our focus is on our youth but providing jobs for 10 employees helps them and their families as well. Together we are fulfilling God's vision for teaching, training, and equipping the young men in Mozambique, Africa.



In November I always like to share needs that help us complete the 2020 year and get ahead for the New Year. If you would like to give above your monthly giving for a Christmas gift to BOHA, here are a few things we need and things we would like to complete:

- 50kg bag of beans and peanuts (this will last about 4 months) - \$250
- Garden supplies, plants, and seeds - \$200 (helps cut cost on food bill)
- Add chickens to our AG program - \$225
- 6 fans for ministry/youth - \$300 (\$50 per fan)
- Outdoor kitchen repairs - \$600
- Extra-large food buys in December - \$1500 (Prices rise in December)

Jesus as this year ends and a new one begins, I pray abundant blessings over all who read this newsletter, who are prayer and financial partners. I pray for healing for all those who are battling the COVID-19 virus, as you are the great physician. This has been a hard year, but you have prevailed and so much has been accomplished despite it all. Jesus thank you for all you have done, are doing, and will do in the days ahead.
