Hello from Mozambique!

Our new youth have arrived and are adjusting to life at BOHA. They are sweet young boys and so thankful and happy to be here. Imagine for a moment that you lived in the bush, had no electricity or running water as they hauled water for a mile or more each day, cooked on an open fire, and sleep on the floor. It took them a few weeks to adjust to beds with sheets, blankets, pillows, and mosquito nets as well as inside bathrooms and a shower. The boys have received new backpacks, all school supplies, and uniforms, as well as personal items like toothpaste, deodorant, soap and lotion. They are all overjoyed with gratefulness and unbelief and know it all came from GOD! They love our church service, working, eating, but are most excited about school and BOHA classes. I forget sometime how young these boys are when they first come, and then when their time is over, they have grown into men.



We have 3 graduates working part time with BOHA and praying that someday we can make them full time, as it's amazing to see the love they have for BOHA and our new youth. Titos is now working with me in the office, living here and being big brother to the youth at night. Bruno will be with us this year working so he can finish 10th grade and complete a course as he is only 17 and has no family. Bruno came from a fellow Globe missionary's ministry and she has found some land for him through her ministry, so we are praying about it. The total needed is \$250 for land and building a small house that will belong to him. Fernando helps in construction but mainly teaching Bible class. I am so proud of him and watching him teach our new youth all that I taught him. Fernando wants to be a pastor and I would love to send him to Bible school in the future but that is a 4-year endeavor and costly. If this is God's plan for him, he could plant a church with BOHA, but there is no salary for a pastor here like it is stateside. Pray with me regarding what is best for him. Our youth already have memorized scriptures, stories and songs because of his diligence and love for Jesus.



I hope this letter has blessed you because without you none of this could happen. Your faithful prayers and financial support for BOHA allows us to minister to so many people because the ripple effect it causes is never ending. I am so proud and grateful for you that you stand with me in the vision for BOHA. Jesus is using you in Africa to share his love, care for many, and watch these young boys become men of God!
