
# Angie Wheeler in Mozambique

## Hello from Mozambique!

Mozambique is opening and is almost back to a new normal, but school is still only 2 days a week for each student. This will give our youth a little more time to learn to read and write with our teacher here, as nine of our youth came to us unable to do either. God is changing lives daily! I see such growth in our youth in just the three months they have been here. They love the church, as well as the classes at BOHA, and they love LEARNING. They are not only growing spiritually, but physically; they even love work duty and that is unusual. I am so proud of all our youth. Praise God for our new desks, books, and Bibles. We were given such a good deal and were able to purchase 30 Bibles. All our youth and staff received a brand-new Bible.

My heart is to share with you what God is doing, in a way that makes you feel like you are a part of what is happening. You are a vital part of this ministry because, without each of you, it could not happen. The call God has given me is not always exciting, it's everyday life. The needs are overwhelming and there is no way one person could do this alone, so God gives us partners who believe in His vision for the youth of Mozambique. I always want you to feel connected and proud of the part you are doing in changing many lives in Mozambique.

Today I had a class with our youth, and so many of them said to me, "I am learning so much now." They attended school for years, but the teacher never had the time or was willing to take the time to answer questions or assist with difficulties. The normal ratio of teacher to a student before COVID was 60-80 students to 1 teacher.



There was never time for her to help each student or keep up with their progress. They are dealing with a lack of confidence and shedding feelings of shame because they are 12 to 14 and cannot read and write. Today we learned about setting personal goals, pushing ourselves to learn to practice, because nothing is free except salvation and the love of God. I asked, "What have you been learning that has changed your life?" Nuno said, "to love your neighbor", another said, "how to pray and work."

Winter is here and it is getting colder each day. Our youth come to us with very little and they need JACKETS ASAP, as well as clothes and shoes for winter. Our ministry has many day-to-day needs, as well as big and small projects that will help us continue to teach and care for our youth.

If you are not a monthly supporter, prayerfully consider joining others in covering us in prayer daily and being a part of meeting the needs of BOHA to help us continue to disciple, train, and equip our youth in building their future and learning to love and accept God's love. Learning how to know Him in their hearts, not just their heads.
