Dear Family Friends and Ministry Partners,

Big things are happening!!! While waiting for our documentation to dig our well in Kululah, we have been able to finish a few other projects we have been working on since February. Thanks to our generous supporters we were able to finish the new Cafeteria/ Multipurpose area at our Transformation Centre. We were also able to modify our kitchen and repair our guard house. This makes it much easier for us to take in more children and better utilize the space. Having the new building also means an opportunity for some of the Princesses to make money towards their building materials by helping me paint. They are so excited; they can add painting to their resume!!!

The children and Princesses studying returned to school in September and are almost ready to wrap up this school year. We are praying for them as they prepare for tests and exams. It has been hard with all the stops and starts with the studies. We will have extra lessons during the school holidays so that they start the 2022 school year strong.

Projects in Process - Forward movement: We have been assembling the Txopelas and preparing them for inspection. We have been praying for reliable, safe, and trustworthy drivers. The documentation and license plates (Number plates) should be ready in November. We will send photos as they are registered and on the road. I will have to go and get an addition to my driver's license because Txopela's require a different license. At least I will be able to drive everything from motor bike to a semi- truck. We can add driver education and safety to the list of vocational skills we offer. It is exciting!!!

"My Future Project" We are praying for the wisdom necessary to steward well the resources we have been given, the experience gained through the years (ours and others) and the time it takes to do these things. Our documentation for the 25 hectares of land progressed to the next level. This next week I should be presented with a few options of locations and then we can choose which will best suit our needs. We want to be close to

electricity and located where the water is safe to drink. While we have been having all the necessary meetings with Chiefs and Administrators, we have been gaining favor and good publicity for the Work

we are doing. The laws changed in the past month stating that they no longer want the children to leave the centres at 18, but 15 years of age. This is crazy... but it does explain the urgency that I and my team have felt to get Kululah prepared. As I mentioned Free the Girls is matching funds with us to build 2 of our Princesses homes this month. We have cleared the land and are ready to begin construction on the first house



Restoration of Families

Reintegration of the Princesses - this entails far more than the physical labor required to build. This is huge!!! It is a Spiritual, Emotional and Physical transition, from all that seemed impossible to the possible. It is overwhelming for many of them. Now, **"All things are possible to those who believe".** Having placed their faith and trust in Jesus is **blowing their minds and paradigms.** Things are happening far faster than they ever thought possible. Going from being homeless, jobless, and family-less, to being loved, accepted, empowered, and trained is amazing. They now have employment through the selling of bras with Free the girls, they are being trained and discipled at our Day Centre and they are learning new skills, some have returned to school. Others are learning how to mother the children they had (formerly abandoned) or the ones they would like to get back in the future, as they gain trust and build relationships with their families or children.

Dance Upon Injustice - The Children from our Transformation Centre have continued with Dance throughout the lockdowns, and they are now ready to perform. In late October we will have a small gathering

of friends and local supporters. The Children will perform our Annual Anti-Human Trafficking Awareness event. A big "thank you" to Mana Ines, our dance instructor/choreographer for her hard work, and patience. We trust this will be a very powerful and life changing- perspective changing event. Please pray with us that God touches hearts and that people respond to the Gospel message.

Prayer Points: ****Please pray we need to hire 2 more Educators.** One for the Transformation Centre and the other For Kululah. (\$150.00 p/m + \$125.00 p/m)

****We need to Finish two bedrooms at the house in Kululah and pave the outside eating area and close it in with Security bars, a gate and Chicken wire.** (This project will cost Roughly \$2,500.00) If you would like to sponsor this project or a portion of it, please let me know in the designation box on the Globe Website. **Thank you!!!!**

****We will be transitioning the older girls to Kululah as school is out at the end of next month.** They will begin preparing their land and gardens, and as funds come in, we will begin building. They will continue to live and study near our Transformation Centre for now, but the transition begins... with free time and planting time coming they will learn how to plant, and harvest on our community property. We must get the big garden area started first so that everyone can eat. They will each be responsible for a portion of the land.

Thank you to all of you who pray for us and support us in so many ways. We are encouraged and spurred on by your faith and belief in God's vision for these Princesses and their precious children. We so appreciate your love and partnership.
