Despite the chaotic world we are living in, we can wait and trust in God that He never changes, that He continues to be true to His Word and plan for humanity. Challenges are part of life and we have faced many, but I believe we can say with confidence that God has been our rock and salvation.

This year has offered distinctive ways to do ministry, mostly online. However, as travel is being resumed, I rejoiced in the opportunity to share in person at the Women of Excellence conference in Michigan. There were about 65 participants. These women look forward to this time of the year when they get together with other women to learn from the Lord but also to fellowship and encourage one another. I brought a teaching on the topic "Rest, Restore, Renew and Release." Each of these topics could have taken the whole amount of time given to me. However, we explored each of them enough to create in us a greater hunger to abide in Christ. I pray that through the power of the Holy Spirit these women were inspired, uplifted, and motivated to keep living with their eyes set on Jesus the author and perfecter of our faith.



At the moment of this writing, I was in Peru pursuing a new field to further the ministry in Latin America. I am thankful for Linda English and the Reimagine Peru Ministry who have paved the way for me to enter the country. Linda and the ministry have been working in Peru since the year 2000. They built prefabricated houses for the most vulnerable people in the largest district of Lima. In her own words, Linda says "I want to flood this district with the love of Jesus." And she has loved the Peruvian people so well that they are receptive to the message of the Gospel. Three church plants have begun in this area that has around 2 million people. They have a national pastor who is working hard to advance the Kingdom. Pastor Pedro hosted the meetings with pastors and leaders of five different churches. I facilitated a conversation on worldview, contrasting the views of the culture and the Bible in topics such as who is God, what is wrong and right, when does human life begin, the weak and the strong.

On the last day, we talked about discipleship. These small conversations were well received, and they also revealed a deep hunger on their part to be trained and equipped. Conversations were begun to have training in the Summer of 2022.

One of them said, “I feel at peace within myself, without the weight of pain and resentment because of the offense.” How wonderful is the power of forgiveness!

I had a good time visiting with my family. My mother is 91 years old, and she is getting very fragile. Please pray for her, that she will commit her life to Jesus.

I thank God for each of you, for your partnership, your prayers, and generous financial support. It is a privilege to represent you in the places where the Lord takes me. Thank you!
