As you may know, the city of San Luis Potosí (Left photo in the collage below) where we live is located 6,150 ft above sea level and is a dry desert climate here on the plateau. Within our own municipality, there is less than 1% evangelicals. This area is ready for "springs of water."

We have made ourselves available to bring the Gospel to them and have had the blessing of seeing much fruit born last year. There is more work to be done here, as we are preparing for a move of God that hasn't been seen before. Our heart this year, is that the Lord would indeed, turn these and even more parched hearts of the people into the garden of the Lord, flowing with spring of living water as only He can do in them and through us.

This past year has been one of great growth for our oldest son Talon. He has embraced life at the J38 campus in Scottsboro, Alabama.
