We were able to advance Dias, our builder, and friend, the materials for him to build a small house for he and his wife and child. This serves as payment for the completing of the two bedrooms, family room and garage in the main house, that will house the girls as their homes are being built. This means that we now have someone present daily who oversees the sale of water and provides security for the property.

For us to begin having the youth spend weekends and school holidays in Kululah, we must finish the main house. This means doing some modifications on our existing building which presents us with some extremely exciting ways we can partner together for progress.

The Transformation Center: We do need to bring in new girls and help those who are desperately in need of a safe place. With a few modifications to our current building in Tchumene, we can house the children/youth we presently have and take in a new group without mixing the groups. The house can be easily divided into two sections. The grounds are big enough that we can have several activities or lessons happening at the same time, in different locations. With the new multipurpose room, (our old cafeteria, being closed in) and our old washing up area, being transformed into a bathroom (toilet, sink and shower) / laundry room, we would have enough space and privacy to do all that we need to in the way of keeping the groups separate for the necessary teaching times etc. We need to move our food storage area, fridges, and freezers out to the kitchen area. This would mean closing a small room, and adding burglar bars and a half wall, as well as raising the roof to create more ventilation. **This project needs to be finished by the end of July, as we will take in the next group of Princesses in early August.** (We currently have 9 Princesses between 15 and 22 years of age and their 7 little children ages 1-3 years, who are willing to commit to 9 months in our discipleship course.) **The necessary modifications and securing of the new room would be between \$2,500 and \$4,000.00.
