We have no plans beyond enjoying a nice steak dinner together at home. No brag, just fact, I can out cook most steak restaurants with my Ninja foodie grill and for a lot less money. Well, Shirley thinks so anyway, and that's what counts. We wanted to go off for a few days but Shirley sees the ophthalmologist on the 8th. Having been diagnosed with glaucoma over 2 years ago, the doctor has tried 3 different kinds of drops to maintain a healthy pressure in her eyes. They have not been successful, plus, she had an allergic reaction. On the 8th he will know if the pressure levels have dropped to his target goal due to the 4 laser procedures that he has done 2 weeks apart for the past 2 months. As of yet she only has peripheral vision in her left eye something only a miracle from the Lord can change. Please keep praying. She can only read with her right eye. She has fallen 3 times in 3 months as she learns to compensate for loss of vision. My Sweet lady doesn't bounce as well as she once did. She is recovering from the last fall and still wears a huge colorful bruise.



Ukrainian refugees

As the war wages on in the Ukraine, reports from Pastor Kriszt Daniel in Debrecen, Hungary shares that refugees continue to stream across the borders looking for refuge and safety. Generous giving to the Ukrainian relief fund has enabled Globe to help provide funds for hands on assistance by helping feed and clothe those he and his congregation have reached out to as well as providing transport from the border to temporary housing. Two simply constructed Gypsy churches that have opened their doors as temporary shelters have now been upgraded with a new heating system and running water to

their buildings. Please continue to keep them in your prayers. We still keep in touch with friends from Shirley's days at the University of Hawaii. In 1970 she met Kathy and Carolyn, 2 Chinese students, on her first day of Uni and they became fast friends. Ron and Kathy recently wrote us. "... Reading your last 2 newsletters, we were reminded of our parents' immigration from China before the Communist regime fell upon the people there. We agonize that the people of Ukraine are experiencing such devastating destruction to their country and loss of lives of loved ones. We pray for God's intervention and His love and victory to prevail and give strength to the people of Ukraine. Thank you for sharing through your newsletter the sacrifice of Pastor Daniel and the people of his church in Hungary."
