Casa de Luz/The Lighthouse: We're enormously blessed to have established a permanent ministry center at La Boquita. What an incredible gift! A former surf lodge, it already has two dormitories, a kitchen and patio area for dining, Bible studies and gatherings with an ocean view. We are currently renovating the buildings. The immediate priority is roof repair. The estimated cost is \$3000. Our goal is to complete the project within the next six months before the next rainy season begins. School for the Deaf: Sylvia and I were assigned as partners in our sign language class. Our task was to present a dialogue by following prompts written on the board. Just before we began, I detected something in her eyes that resembled terror, so I began the dialogue and queued her in. We flowed smoothly together in our sign language dialogue. Later in the day, I discovered that Sylvia is illiterate. Suddenly, she grew in size as I realized the sacrifice she was making in order to learn sign language so that she can communicate beyond the basics with her deaf son, Enrique. Enrique started learning sign language at the age of 18 when he enrolled in the school for the deaf. Now, at 23, he is in the ninth grade and is in need of a sponsor to continue attending the school. Sewing Classes: Among the students in our current sewing class are four interpreters for the deaf. We are working on a project for the next six weeks, making shoulder bags. The next class will include deaf women who will each have an interpreter as a sewing partner. Pray for these women to know the unconditional love of their heavenly Father. Pray that each one would know for certain that God has a great plan for her life. It is so so beautiful to witness the expressions on their faces while sewing.

Elijah's Pantry: We had been trying for a while to contact Santiago, a surfer from the community of La Boquita, whose brother drowned several months ago. We drove around the community asking if anyone knew where he lived. He got word that we were looking for him and came to meet us in the street. We talked and prayed with him, then blessed him and his family with groceries from Elijah's Pantry. Pray for Santiago, and his family, to receive comfort from the Lord in their grief.
