This week is preparation week for me as I will be traveling with two friends/colleagues to Zambia and Malawi. This is a Training the Trainers' event where we work with pastors and leaders that have attended The Journey of the Life Giver (our first training).

The purpose is that the participants who have been actively sharing the curriculum will gain greater ownership of the materials and the techniques for using it well. As they have shared with others, they have encountered some challenges, perhaps teaching some sessions has been uncomfortable or maybe they need more understanding of parts of the material. Through practical activities, we seek to encourage, mentor, and coach these brothers and sisters, equipping them for ministry multiplication.

The group in Malawi is formed by seminary students. Pastor Max, our host in Malawi sent a prayer guide that I would like to share with you so that you can join us in prayer for the participants:

Please add to your prayers travel mercies, health, and a safe return. The trip is from October 16th to the 30th.

One of the beauties of traveling internationally is the many people you get to meet. In one of my travels to Kenya, I became friends with a sweet, yet strong lady. Her name is Nimo, she is a devoted Christian, a mother of two teenage children, and a hard-working woman who wants to bring the Gospel message to the Maasai, a people group near the border of Kenya and Tanzania. She visits the community constantly and she works towards meeting many of the social needs they have. She has developed a rapport with the leaders and community so that she is able to teach them about Female Genital Mutation, a very traumatic practice that damages women at an early age. Her mission to the Maasai includes bringing material as well as practical help. She said that children in the community have to walk 9 miles every day to the closest school. She has built a two-room school to help them.



In a conversation I had with her, she told me of the need for a portable rechargeable speaker that will help her in her training events. The cost is \$500.00. I want to present to you this opportunity to be a part of the life-giving work that is happening in Kenya and more specifically the Maasai community.
