She is working her way back to health in a rehab center. The day she fell, she called me saying, "I've called 911. I'm sure I've broken my hip." I was in Minnesota; she was in Texas. What could I do? I called her neighbor, who, thankfully, was home and went to stay with her, and stayed on the phone with me, until the ambulance came.

I mentioned last month that we held our Member Care Team training days. It was a packed two days with Dr. Andy Yarborough learning more tools to help Globe missionaries succeed and remain in their host countries. This is the purpose of Member Care: thriving in their field of service. Dr. Yarborough says, "So what is a productive conversation? It's when two people communicate in such a way that both people feel heard and validated. People do not have to agree with each other. They just need to feel heard and validated." One of our goals with Member Care is that our missionaries feel they are heard and cared for.
