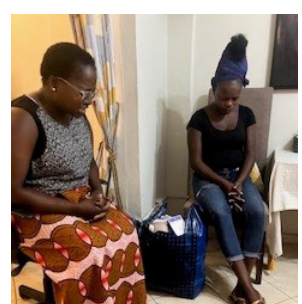

Dear Family, Friends, and Ministry Partners,

Thank you for your prayers! We're happy to report that we are well and "dry" despite being hit by the same cyclone 3 times...that must be a record. Please keep those displaced by the flooding in your prayers. **RAIN, RAIN, AND MORE RAIN.** Many roads and bridges were washed away. People are slowly returning home after staying in schools etc. We were cut off for a couple of weeks from our property in Kululah because of the damage to the roads. We had to have major work done on our 4x4 because of the water and mud. The roads here are hard on vehicles but the conditions lately have been extreme. We are grateful for the Lord's provision of a little car gifted to us by one of our volunteers last year in November. It has helped as our 4x4 has been in the shop for the past month.

**HOW IS THE RESTRUCTURING GOING?** Restructuring was the answer and the only legal way we could do what needed to be done quickly. It helped us eliminate those staff members who, due to Covid etc., had been working "against" our vision. It is also enabling us to do some renovations, painting, and maintenance on the buildings that would have been difficult if every room were fully occupied. So, we are grateful for some "room to move" and to reconfigure bedrooms and multi-purpose spaces. The Centre is NOT closed (never was) but it's not running as it had. I do not have a children's Centre. The Transformation Centre is a center for girls who have come out of prostitution or human trafficking and their children if they have them... we work with girls 10-24 years old so there may be children at my Centre, but since we were left with 24 abandoned kids over the years it took time to locate their families and re-integrate them or create substitute families for them. It is still operational and there are staff and two children still living there and attending school. We are still in the process of working with the families of the children reintegrated with regards to school transfers. So, lots of work, because the children live in different bairros now and we are working with several schools, but it is good. They are all healthy and doing well. **The children in our Sponsorship program are still being sponsored as they transition, the monies help with transport for school, and food parcels. Our sponsors are aware of the transition.**

**A TIME FOR EVERYTHING:** We would like to thank everyone who has helped us by supporting Free the Girls in Mozambique since 2010. Hundreds of Princesses have been able to buy land, build, renovate houses, finish high school, and continue their studies because of the generosity and incredible opportunities Free the Girls has offered the girls interested in business. We heard from FTG in the States that they will be closing the ministry here. They will continue working in El Salvador and Uganda. We trust that just as the Lord supplied the opportunity to partner with FTG, HE will also supply partnerships for this next season. A group of 14 Princesses just graduated in February and the remaining girls will finish in the next three months.



**THE FISH ARE JUMPING IN THE BOAT!!!** We are experiencing a great harvest of souls here in Mozambique!!! The Princesses are bringing new friends every day and the girls are responding to the Gospel. The Word Works. God is setting them free and giving them a sense of purpose and dignity. It is so exciting to see. They are arriving early and staying late. Our volunteers are really getting to see firsthand what revival looks like. God is moving in such a precious and powerful way. We had 8 new Princesses accept Christ as their Savior in one week. God is transforming lives. We love the way He works!!! **We are training new team members, volunteers, and leaders. That has been going very well.**

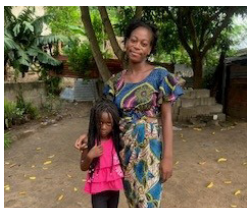
