In 2022 we unexpectedly landed in the U.S. for an entire school year. We felt uncertain, frustrated, and confused. Our hearts were in Ukraine, so why did the Lord have us in America? We followed the Lord's leading to stay, but never could have imagined the ways in which God would fill our hearts. We invested in our marriage, spent time with family, received help with education,


and healed from many years in ministry. Our prayer had been, "Lord we will go where you want us to go." And the answer was, "Wait."

In January 2023, we felt a stirring to pray about the future. The answer changed from "Wait" to "Seek". We prayed, sought counsel, and brainstormed all our ideas onto huge posters. We considered many options, including staying in Alabama. Through discussions with Globe leadership and other partners, we felt God leading us to continue as missionaries to Ukrainians.

Madison's trip to Bucharest last year with Lifeline and (un)adopted kept

coming to mind. A need to help displaced Ukrainians still exists, so is this where God wants to take us? We decided that Yura and Chambers should go on a trip to Bucharest to meet with organizations and ministries serving Ukrainians in Romania. On their trip, they spent time with new Romanian friends, Ukrainians, and even

friends from Odesa! The answer changed from "Seek" to "Arise, go!".



Yura got a whole week with just Chambers! They explored Bucharest and met with potential partners.

Our family's mission is to serve vulnerable children, families, refugees, and the unreached to bring restoration and redemption in Christ.

After much prayerful consideration, we are certain that to carry out this mission we are to move back overseas!

We will be serving Ukrainians, based out of Bucharest. This will enable us to care for our family, engaging Ukrainians refugees with the Gospel and

long-term discipleship, while being close enough to Ukraine to remain informed and connected to our partners.

Whether you have followed our family since we launched to Ukraine in 2018

or only since the full-scale invasion began in 2022, we invite you to partner with us on this journey!
