As I mentioned in our last update, a vida220 team from Vidanet is finishing their outreach in Siquirres. We've enjoyed getting to know them, and have spent a lot of time with them, working at the church, youth groups, and playing cards. It's fun to hear their stories, dreams and passions, and how their journey has been throughout the discipleship school. They only have a week or so left, so we're trying to make the most of it!

We started Alpha, a video course for youth with one of the churches up the mountain from the church. Youth from Siguirres are in charge of leading this Alpha, and we love to see them developing their leadership skills and working together in a team.

When we were appointed youth pastors, we decided to create a team to support, encourage and brainstorm together. This team is made up of youth from the church who we believe have great potential, leadership gifts, and would be able to continue COME if we were to not be



able to be present. We have recently been meeting with them to talk about how we can be more intentional in reaching out into the community and also strengthen the youth that are already within the youth group. We care deeply for each one on our team, and our desire is to see them continue to grow in the gifts God has given them and encourage them. The other week we traveled to San Jose with them to receive a course about teaching the Bible to youth.
