INTERVIEW WITH THE PEREKOTIY KIDS

With only days before our big move, stressors and logistics are at an alltime high. Our precious kids also have emotional needs bigger than ever before. Our family trusts the Lord to care for us! Yuriy and I trust that God cares for our children more than we do. Those truths are a foundation under some really intense emotions in our family. We want you to hear from our kids what makes their Third Culture Kid life so hard and beautiful! (Remi participated in a very 3-year-old way, answering "Sprinkles!" to everything!).



What foods do you miss in Ukraine?

Chambers: kvas (wheat drink) **Lev**: vareniki (dumplings with sweet filling)

Mila: kefir, oilvye (potato and pickle salad)

What will you miss most about living in Alabama?

Chambers: My friends.

Lev: Family. That's an easy answer. And Tortilla.

Mila: Tortilla and our house.

What is your best travel advice?

Chambers: Try to fall asleep if it's nighttime; put everything back in your bag after you open it, and zip it so it doesn't fall out on the floor! Lev: Chew gum or a lollipop when you take off to pop your ears. Mila: Try to use inside voices!

What was it like when you found out we were moving again?

Chambers: I was hoping it would never happen. But when it was official, I felt nervous, I didn't want to move again.

Lev: I was thinking you'd change your minds. I felt nervous, because I didn't want to go. Scared.

Mila: I felt sad and surprised. Because it was just all weird feelings.




