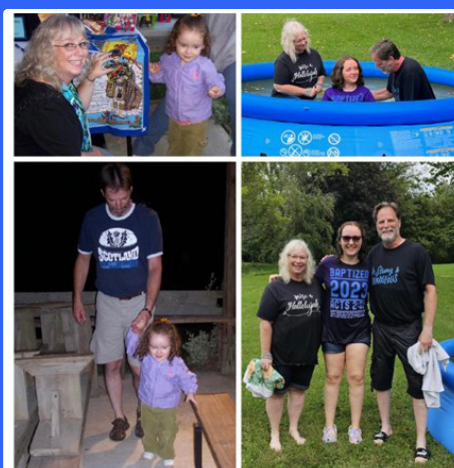
Hello Friend

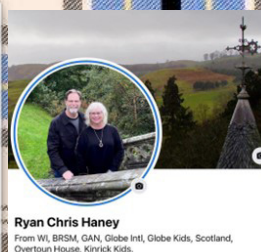

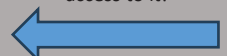
