What does a day look like in the Preschool?

The majority of our children, who are from Nicaragua, wake up at 4:00 in the morning in order for their mommas to get them ready and drop them off at our school at 6:00 am. At 7:30 we all pray and eat breakfast together and then the babies all take a little nap. Our two and three year olds then get to do physical activities and dance, they even sing in English! After all the activity, we all need a snack. At 10:00 everyone goes to the "Park/Playground" and the children get to play in our outdoor covered area, this also promotes sharing and socialization.



At 11:00, two of our teachers go up and receive the other children from public school to come to what they call their "favorite fish school (because our name means, The Savior's 'little fish').

They play together for a little while and then everyone again prays and eats lunch. They all love Bernarda's food. Many days the children tell her she has 11 out of ten stars! After lunch, all the babies take an afternoon nap and the school age children do class and Bible stories. Then at 1:00 in the afternoon, the preschool is quiet and every little one is asleep. Can you imagine 32 children sleeping at the same time?! At two everyone is awake, has their snack and play until the parents pick them up at 3:00. Whew, it is a fun filled day for sure.



These next months at the school are our busiest months. We need lots of prayers over the little ones and our amazing staff.
