We also held a party the night before with friends and family and worshipped into the night on our front lawn.

We were also invited this month to share with Thai pastors in the Northeastern region about our church planting efforts among the villages encouraging them to reach out to the people outside the cities. The group Hug Isaan is a fellowship of pastors from different denominations seeking to reach the goal of planting a church in each the 2,678 subdistricts of the Northeastern area. There are 23 million people in this region and only 45,000 believers. There is still much work to be done. We are encouraged to see the Thai and Laos people begin church planting among the unreached.

After we finished sharing about our work in the villages, a team of Wycliffe translation representatives came up to meet us. Wycliffe is interested in recording audio translations of the Bible into the Northeastern dialect. Media is so important for this task because Isaan is largely a spoken language instead of a written one. They came on Sunday to one of our house churches to meet and interview some of our members to aid in their translation task. We hope to someday soon have the audio Bible in Isaan language.
